Instruction for Authors

1. Article should follow **IMRAD** format
2. Articles should be **3500 to 7000** words (including references and appendices).
3. Times New Roman in 12 point font size is to be followed. **1.15 spaces** must be there. Pagination should be 1 inch on all sides on an A4 paper. No need to mention page number.
4. APA 7th style should be followed.
5. The author's details and contact should be on a separate page (first page), and the **title** (maximum 12 words), the **abstract** (150 to 200 words), the **key words** (4-7 words) and the article should start from the second page.
6. Tables, charts, graphs should be numbered and clearly visible in black and white (Follow APA 7th style).
7. If there is any **acknowledgment or declaration**, it should be mentioned before references. Appendices should be placed after references. Please avoid long appendices.
8. Footnotes are not allowed.
9. Authors will be responsible for plagiarism. Plagiarized writing from any author might result in cancelling that particular author from submitting writing in this journal later on.
10. The article should be in **MS word file form with at least 15 references**.
